# Yoma Yangon International Marathon 2018 Race Date Announcement



**Yangon, Myanmar, 22 September 2017** - Yoma Strategic Holdings Ltd. ("Yoma Strategic"), co-organiser of the annual Yoma Yangon International Marathon ("YYIM") is pleased to announce that the 2018 event will take place on Sunday, 21 January 2018, and registration will begin on Monday, 25 September 2017, at 9 am.

2018 will mark the 6<sup>th</sup> year of the Marathon. The event has grown from strength to strength over the years – from a race of just around 1,000 participants in 2013 to becoming the largest participatory running event in Yangon with over 8,000 runners in 2017. The annual event is jointly organised with First Myanmar Investment Co., Ltd. (FMI) and Yangon City Development Committee (YCDC).

Mr Melvyn Pun, CEO of Yoma Strategic said, "The Yoma Yangon International Marathon has become one of the city's most recognised annual sporting event. Held in January each year, it's a healthy way to kick-start a new year. This year, we hope to further increase the registration numbers as we believe this marathon is a great platform to bring the Yangon community together. An important part of the event is the joint effort in giving back to the community or as we call it 'Run for Children'. We invite participants and the public to raise money and donate to support youth and truly make a difference in their lives."

In 2017, the funds raised for charity were channelled to five projects. The first was improving the welfare of children living and studying at Zeyar Shwe Myay Youth Development Center, Hlaing Tharyar, Yangon Division. Donation was made to supplement education for more than 400 children, providing them an opportunity to flourish and develop in a healthier and safer environment. The second project was YCDC Non-Profit Child Day Care Centre for low income citizens where we contributed financial support to YCDC for its early childhood care and kindergarten education to over 100 children across six Yangon locations. A third project was donating to Nan Oo Youth Development Center, Mayangone Township, Yangon Division, which provides education for 200 students, many of whom are orphans from conflict affected areas. A fourth project was to build the dining hall (canteen area) at Su Htoo Pan Youth Development Center, (Than Lyin) Yangon Division to improve the welfare of 400 children living and studying at the center. The fifth project was donating to No (3) Basic Middle School of Hlaing Tharyar, Daisu Village, Yangon Division where we aided in the building of a facility within the school compound.

## Registration for YYIM 2018

Registration for the YYIM 2018 will take place from 25 September 2017 to 15 December 2017. The YYIM 2018 race categories and registration fees are listed below.

Local and foreign participants can enjoy online registration rate through Wave Money payment system by registering online at <u>www.yomayangonmarathon.com</u> or in-person at Room No. (8-11), Kwan Chan Street, Aung San Football Stadium (South Wing), YOMA Bank Home Loan Center, Mingalar Taung Nyunt Township, Yangon, Myanmar. Registration begins from 9am to 4.30pm, Monday-Friday. The office will be closed on public holidays in Myanmar.

Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Runners are encouraged to register early to avoid disappointment.

Participants must be aged 16 years and above as of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017 to participate in the Full Marathon and Half Marathon categories. Participants must be aged 12 years and above as of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017 to participate in the 10km Challenge category. There are no age restrictions for the 3km Fun Run/ Walk category.

The YYIM 2018 will take place at the Thuwanna Indoor Stadium. The official course routes for YYIM 2018 will be announced closer to the event date and will be available for viewing on the event website (<u>www.yomayangonmarathon.com</u>). The marathon course routes will include some of the iconic sites in Yangon such as Botahtaung Pagoda, Shwedagon Pagoda and Inya Lake.
