Dulwich College International confirms entry into Myanmar with two Yangon campuses

Part of a capital investment of more than US\$30 million by Yoma Strategic Holdings in the development of campuses in Pun Hlaing and Thanlyin Star City, both set to open for the 2017/2018 academic year

Yangon, Myanmar, Tuesday 26 April 2016 – Today Dulwich College International (DCI) announced formally its entry to Myanmar. The two campuses in the Yangon townships of Hlaing Thayar and Thanlyin will be collectively known as Dulwich College Yangon. The College will act as one educational institution operating across two sites. Dulwich College Yangon will be the first international school in Myanmar with a direct link to a renowned British independent school in the UK.

Funded by a capital investment of more than US\$30 million by Yoma Strategic Holdings, Dulwich College Yangon will boast state of the art facilities across its two campuses. The College in Yangon joins the family of Dulwich College International schools in Shanghai, Beijing, Suzhou, Seoul and Singapore, along with two International High Schools in Suzhou and Zhuhai and, the founding school, Dulwich College in London.

A reception marking the launch of Dulwich College Yangon was hosted this evening by His Excellency Mr Andrew Patrick, British Ambassador to Burma at the British Ambassador's Residence, Alan Pya Road, Yangon. On the decision to establish Dulwich College in Yangon, His Excellency stated:

“It brings me great pleasure to welcome Dulwich College to Burma; founded in 1619 the College is one of the UK's oldest and most prestigious independent schools. The influx of British educational provision of this calibre will be a huge benefit to Burma.”

Dulwich College Yangon Pun Hlaing campus (which will remain Pun Hlaing International School until August 2016) is accepting admissions for the 2016/2017 academic year at its current campus. Admissions will open in June 2016 for the first intake of students at the College's Star City campus (formally British College Yangon) for the following academic year in August 2017.

The Right Honourable Peter Riddell, CBE, Chairman of the Dulwich College Board of Governors and Old Alleynian (1959-66), stated “It is truly an honour that we are able to launch Dulwich College Yangon during a period of such change and optimism in Myanmar. We are pleased to widen the access to a Dulwich education further with the opening of the College in Yangon.”

Fraser G. White, Founder and Executive Chairman, Dulwich College International commented “The Dulwich College Yangon campus facilities will stand as testament to our [Yoma Strategic's and DCI's] shared vision of developing a world-class international education in Myanmar, and will offer exceptional prospects for the Myanmar and foreign students who will use them”.

Mr Christian Guertler, CEO of Dulwich College International spoke on behalf of the DCI group: “We fully intend to play our part and contribute to Myanmar's growth by providing a world-class educational offering for local students as well as the growing expatriate community.”

Mr Melvyn Pun, Chief Executive Officer and Executive Director Yoma Strategic Holdings commented “Yoma Strategic is pleased that Dulwich College Yangon will open in both Pun Hlaing Golf Estate and Star City. We are confident the world-class facilities and Dulwich's excellent education standard will greatly benefit our community and contribute to developing the leaders in our next generation.”

Mr Daryl Orchard, founding Headmaster of Dulwich College Yangon said, “Dulwich College Yangon offers a friendly, student-centred learning environment. Our academic programme runs in conjunction with a comprehensive extra-curricular programme, ensuring the College is able to provide a wealth of artistic, sporting, and cultural opportunities for our students to engage in, both in Yangon and across the Dulwich College International family of schools.”

“We offer a British independent school style of education, while at the same time recognising the importance of studying Myanmar language and culture. We will also offer our students the Dulwich College International Mandarin programme,” added Mr Orchard.

Dulwich College Yangon

Admissions for Dulwich Colleges Yangon's Pun Hlaing Campus are open on a rolling basis, accepting students for both the 2016/17 and 2017/18 academic year to the Early Years, Junior School and Middle School age groups. Admissions for Dulwich College Yangon's Star City campus will open in June 2016 for its first intake of students in August 2017. The campus will cater to Early Years, Junior School and Senior School students up to Year 8, with an additional year group being offered each academic year up to Year 13.

Dulwich College Yangon is an academically selective, co-educational British independent school, offering an enhanced version of the English National Curriculum, adapted to the needs of its international student body. The College's enhanced curriculum, leads to the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) examinations in Years 10 and 11 and then, in Years 12 and 13, a challenging international, academic qualification which is fully recognised by, and gives access to, leading universities worldwide. DCI's international Colleges in Asia follow the IBDP curriculum in Years 12 and 13.

State of the art facilities across both sites include a 500-seat performing arts centre, 350-seat black box theatre, science laboratories, art and design studios, libraries, gymnasias, 25m and 50m swimming pools, and sports fields. The College campuses will be set within landscaped greenfield sites of more than 12 acres at Pun Hlaing campus and more than 20 acres at Star City. Developments at both campuses will be completed in time for the 2017/2018 academic year.

Dulwich College International (DCI) is a family of academically selective, co-educational and secular international schools for students from 2 to 18 years of age. Since 2003, DCI has established five Colleges for international students in Shanghai, Beijing, Suzhou, Seoul and Singapore, as well as two Dulwich International High Schools in Zhuhai and Suzhou, primarily for Chinese students wishing to study at university abroad.
